Any non-hazardous waste, including but not limited to:

Appliances	Insulation
Cardboard	Paper and Paper Products
Carpet	Plastic
Carpet Pad	Roofin Materials
Drywall	Steel
Furniture	Tile
Household Goods	Wood
Masonry Materials (brick, concrete, stone **must be pre-approved by the office**)	Water Based Paint (**wet paint must be sealed tightly and double bagged, as the containers are not water tight**)

UNACCEPTABLE WASTE

All Hazardous Wastes including but not limited to:

Antifreeze	Oil Filters
Asbestos	Flammable Liquids
Batteries	Paint (oil-based)
Chemical Products	Propane Tanks
Fire Extinguishers	Radioactive Materials
Herbicides and Pesticides	Solvents
Medical Waste	Transmission/Lubricating/Hydraulic Oils
Motor Oil	Railroad Ties
Contaminated Oils (mixed with solvents, gasolines, etc.)	Tires

HOW TO LOAD A DUMPSTER

The dumpster cannot be filled above the rim or sides. If the dumpster is loaded above the rim or sides and cannot be tarped, we cannot remove the container and customer will be charged a trucking fee.
